Case Study: Princess Royal Hospital

The Client

Princess Royal Hospital is part of the Shrewsbury & Telford NHS Trust and has been a client of Ware 4 since 2002.

The Challenge

Sian Brookes, Catering Services Manager, required an updated food service trolley to replace the time served fleet of discontinued Bristol Maid trolleys which had been in use in the hospital for many years.



A site visit was conducted by Ware 4 to discuss the issue in detail with all staff who used the trolleys.

Criteria were set

A stainless steel wheeled unit suitable for transporting meals from the kitchen to the wards and collecting returns

Easy to manoeuvre – options for free, fixed and braking wheels

Top storage area with hinged up and over door

The inside top working area to be removable

A front fabric cover, grey or brown in colour to keep messy residue from view

A bumper guard completely around the bottom of the trolley

Rounded handles at one end and clips or hooks at the other for bag waste

A removable inner shelf for maximum use of space

Easy to clean

The Solution

A purpose built, modern version of a tried and trusted classic. Produced to order in one of the leading commercial kitchen production facilities in the UK.

After design submissions and revisions a standard was agreed by PRH and production began.
