Case Study – The Whittington Hospital



Ware 4 were approached by The Whittington Hospital NHS Trust's Environmental Manager, Alan Perry, to help provide suitable recycling facilities for their busy 470-bed site.

The Challenge

The Whittington Hospital had a strict budget to adhere to and also required a sturdy recycling unit which would be easy to clean and empty.

Ware 4 offer a selection of 'pre-loved' (reused) bins at a reduced rate which appealed to The Whittington for both environmental and budgetary reasons.

The Solution

The Whittington Hospital purchased 77 x blue Slim Jim 87 litre units with swing lids for the collection of recyclable waste.

They selected the 87 litre option from our best-selling Slim Jim range in order to collect mixed recyclable waste throughout the hospital buildings. The Slim Jims are shaped efficiently to fit into a limited amount of space, do not rust, chip or peel, even if used outdoors and are easy to clean, providing an even longer lifespan. The Slim Jims are also available in a variety of different coloured bodies and lids to simplify waste separation, especially in



large scale recycling schemes such as that needed at The Whittington.

The recycling system has been implemented successfully throughout the hospital.

The bins will be used to collect mixed recyclables and will be placed in various departments, including the staff restaurant, and wards throughout the hospital..."
